

Station 1 - Town Hall

Originally, the two-floor building in proper of an open square, was built in 1930 as a first separate post office and it is under monumental protection, since 1988.

The ground floor of the main building accommodated the ticket hall and many offices.

On the first floor, the official residence of the head official and rooms for communications facilities like telegraphy and manual exchange were accommodated. Both side wings were store rooms and parking opportunities for cars.

The post office Landstuhl was responsible for 74 surrounding communities and was one of the biggest ones in Rhineland Palatinate.

After the policy decision of the city council of Sickingenstadt Landstuhl in 1986 and the groundbreaking in 1993, the former post office and nowadays town hall was initiated in 1996 as a modern cultural and congressional centre.

Contemporary architectural stylistic elements were put into the landmarked frontage of the former post office.

Congresses, exhibitions and cultural events at its finest, in-house productions like 'Palatinate Comedy' and its child theatre, make the town hall of Sickingenstadt Landstuhl well-known beyond regional borders.
